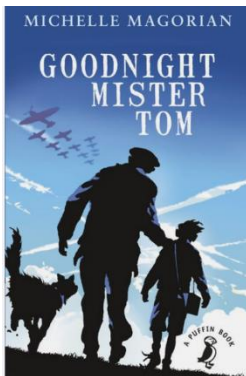




We have very quickly reached Spring Term!!! What a brilliant start to the year we have had!

English

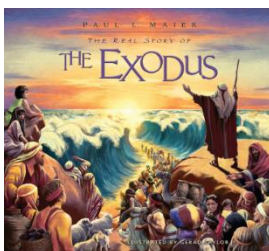

Our next unit will be poetry where we will write an imagery poem based on the war.

Maths

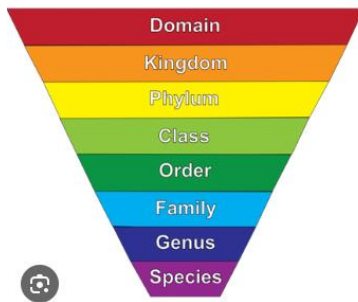
This half-term we will be looking deeper into the reasoning side of maths. We will have our first look at place value, the four operations and then we will progress to fractions.

Science
