OUR LEARNING

English- We will begin the half-term by reading folk tales, focusing on Brer Rabbit and his mischievous adventures. Following this, we will write our own newspaper reports.

Maths- We will continue developing our multiplication and division skills, building on prior knowledge. Times tables remain very important, so regular practice is encouraged. We will then move on to a statistics unit focusing on graphs, before starting a new unit on fractions just before half-term.

Science- Electricity: Circuits and Conductors. We will explore insulators and conductors by investigating simple circuits and testing everyday materials through hands-on experiments.

Geography- We will be learning about the United Kingdom, identifying and describing its key geographical features. We will also locate the counties of the UK, as well as identify and find towns and cities on a map.

R.E- Jesus. We will explore why Christians believe Jesus is the Son of God, developing an understanding of authority. We will learn why Jesus is believed to have authority and identify ways in which he showed this.

Homework & reading- As always, homework is set every week. Please ensure that your child completes by Wednesday. Spellings are set on Spelling Frame, and they are also provided in the homework folder every week. Reading is a key part of your child's learning, so please try and read with your child as much as possible.

Times tables- as mentioned at parents' evening, the children will have to sit a times tables test in June. Please keep practising at home, either on TTRS or using your own resources.
