**Year 1:** Hayley Dillon for helping your friends at playtime.

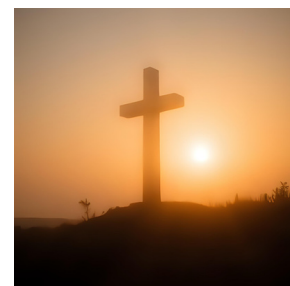
**Year 2:** Harvey Rosier for being a great help. You always spot the little jobs that make things easier for others. Thank you!
